

#### Access

## Earth quake & fire:

#### Lunch:

Lunch is prepared every Sunday in the kitchen on the first floor and will be served between 12:45 - 13:30h. Our guests are invited to join us for free.

However, long-stay guests and permanent members are asked to pay their lunch. Please ask for the actual price (< 500 JPY).



<u>Attention</u>: If there is a 5th Sunday in the month and during summer months, lunch will not be served. You can buy your own lunch in one of the convenience stores or supermarkets in the area. If you need assitance, please ask.

#### Mother & kids room:

In the back of the hall (3rd floor) you will find a room, where mothers with small kids can go, if the kids are too small to attend calmly the worship and ministy. Sorry, but no brothers allowed in this room.

#### **Translation:**
